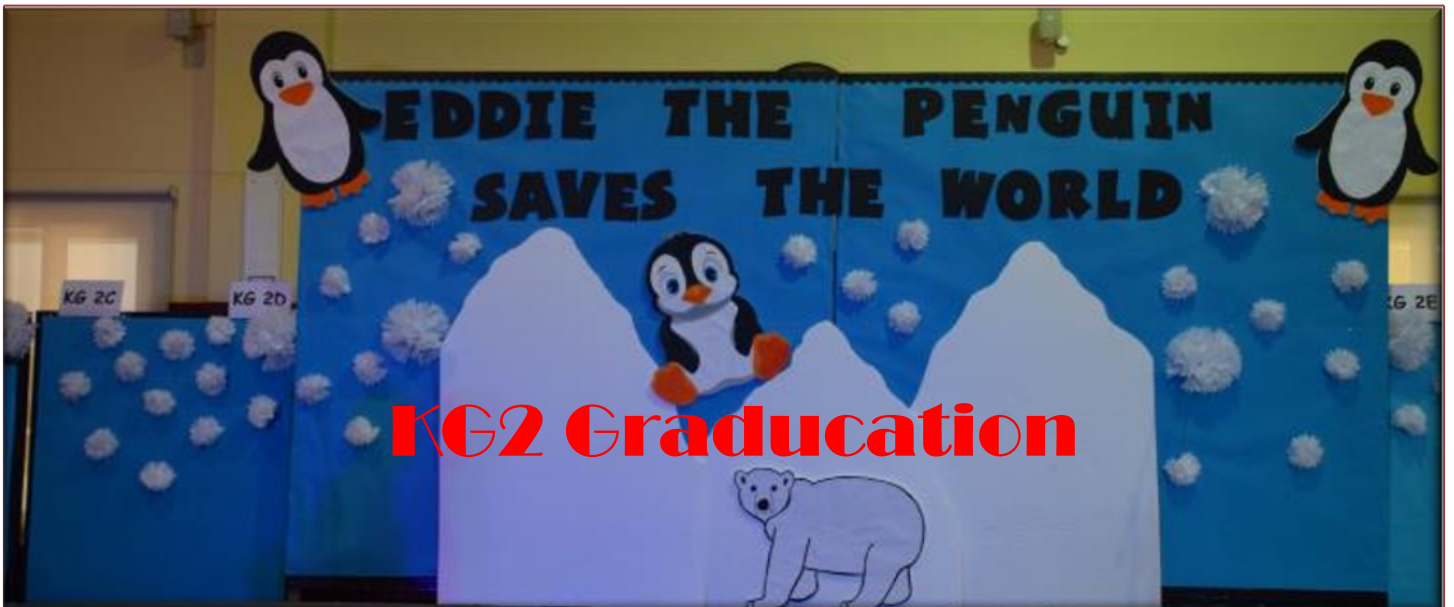

News from Grade 3

During Unit 6 'Finding resolutions to conflict between people may lead to a better quality of human life' Grade 3 participated in the Water Alliance workshop. During the workshop students were exposed to different real-life situations which are occurring in our world right now. They were assigned passports from developed and less developed countries and based on their allocation they received their water allowance. It really helped us to understand how children and families living in less developed countries struggle to meet their daily water needs. Grade 3 showed how they are caring PYP learners and displayed their empathy for their peers around the world. They proposed effective, innovative solutions for water-related conflict and proposed plans to share with world leaders. Grade 3 teachers were really impressed with their suggestions such as:



- ◆ The world's water should be distributed equally depending on the population of a country
- ◆ Developed countries should share their resources with less developed countries
- ◆ Water should be provided in areas where there are drought to avoid conflict
- ◆ A Worldwide Water Council should be established to ensure the world's water is being used responsibly
- ◆ Rivers that run through more than one country should be protected so that one country doesn't use more than it needs
- ◆ The needs of the community should be balanced to ensure there is enough water for everyone
